Blended Learning is a teaching approach that uses both digital and traditional teaching methods to help our pupils learn. In the current climate, there may be times when individuals or contact groups need to isolate. By using a Blended Learning approach this year, we will be able to support our children in their learning of Literacy and Numeracy and all other Areas of Learning and Experience from a distance should the need arise. All distance learning is posted on Google Classroom or on Flipgrid for nursery. Please contact your child's teacher if you need log in details for any of our digital platforms.

These activities are designed to be done independently following instruction. ✓ Nursery – teachers will email parents individually. ✓ FP & KS2 - Five sessions of maths and five sessions of literacy will be posted on Google Classroom at start of each week. <p>Please complete tasks in order and only complete one maths and one literacy task a day so that if/when you return to school, your child will be in sync with the children who have been learning in school.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Learning via Mathletics and Reading Eggs will be ongoing. ✓ Homework will be completed digitally. 	<p>One or more contact groups have been asked to isolate for a specific period of time because of a confirmed positive COVID-19 case.
